Place: St Paul's Church, Brackley Road, Beckenham, BR3 1RB Parking: Free parking in surrounding streets

Important extra info:

- interval refreshments thank you everyone who has volunteered to bring cake/treats for interval refreshments. Please can you <u>write an ingredients list</u> to go with the food
- Please bring cash and ask your audience members to bring cash for donation entry (no set price tickets), for interval refreshments and for raffle tickets and other extras (there will probably be one card machine, but the reception in the church is dodgy so this is not a good option)
- Small Ensemble will be singing in the interval and we'll be selling a few things to help raise money for our big fundraiser. Please let your audience members know this too!

Audience:

Please bring people! The church seats 350 so the more the merrier! **Entry is by donation** and you don't need to book in advance.

Safeguarding:

Please be aware there will be children and young people in the band. I'll put a copy of the CPPB safeguarding policy in the members' area for you to read, and the most relevant section is here, concerning code of conduct during our joint rehearsals and gig:

The responsibilities of all adult band (and choir) members during rehearsals and gigs are:

- To ensure they are not alone with any young or vulnerable members of the band during rehearsals. The most likely place for this to happen is when fetching or returning equipment to the basement.

- To avoid travelling with or giving lifts to unaccompanied young people. The band cannot arrange lifts for young players, this should be a private arrangement between parents where it is necessary.

- To help supervise unaccompanied young people or vulnerable adults if requested by the safeguarding lead (eg if the SL is accompanying other children to the toilet and needs to leave the main band area)

- Although not strictly required, it would be good practice to tell the person sitting next to you if you need to leave the rehearsal room/building during the rehearsal or gig and when you will be back. This is because there is a very small risk of injury/fall etc and we need to be aware if people have not returned so we can investigate.

- To report any safeguarding concerns to the safeguarding lead in the first instance

FIRST HALF - Choir (about 15mins music)

- What's Christmas Without a Brass Band? Unison tune for choruses and Merry Christmas ONLY (would be lovely to split into harmony for one line at the end of the chorus 'what's Christmas without a brass band', as in the recording on resources page, but not essential)

INTERVAL

- Small Ensemble sing 3 pieces, about 9mins, while everyone getting refreshments (Shallow, California, Have Yourself a Merry)
- Palace Ac flashmob with Chariots of Fire (2.5mins) to get audience back to seats (if possible). Otherwise new lyrics by Bev for Come Follow Me round
- Draw raffle

Choir Band and Audience

- Traditional Carols X 2
- Jingle Bells verse 1, chorus, verse 1 again, chorus. Band are bringing bells for us to have some fun with too.

Choir and Band

- White Xmas Band intro (?), choir sing once through a cappella first, NO KEYCHANGE, then band take over and choir unison on tune
- We Wish You a Merry Christmas everyone unison on tune! NB band intro to every verse.
